VIEW FROM THE BRIDGE



On March 11, I was certain that we would be able to have both the brunch and the general membership meeting on Sunday (3/15).

But by mid-day on Thursday, it was apparent from the steady tide of warnings and questions, that our Sunday events needed to be cancelled. Then, the situation became even worse!

All SOS events for the months of March, April and first week of May have been cancelled. This includes the Cruising Kick off, scheduled for April 19; the Flare and Safety Demo and the Dockside Training scheduled for May 2. We will monitor the virus situation as it evolves and then make a decision before proceeding with future events. The Cruising Kick Off will not be rescheduled, but the coordinator training will be held on line and via small groups or mentors.

The last SOS brunch for the winter/spring has been rescheduled for May 31. The general membership meeting will follow the brunch on May 31. This is an important membership meeting as we will be discussing the proposed change of our current dues structure for all members. These changes will have the most impact on our Lifetime Members.....for more on this issue, see the article on page 2.

Despite the brunch cancellation, your intrepid Board of Directors met as

scheduled on Sunday, March 15. Several important decisions were made including the approval of new membership directories, and approval to give brunch vouchers to those who were signed up for the March 15 brunch. This electronic voucher will be as good as cash for a future brunch! Giving a voucher is sort of like a store credit and saves the club money charged for each refund processed through our web site.

Another cancellation was just announced. The SV *Maiden* sadly cancelled their long-planned tour up the east coast. Corona virus issues made their planned stops untenable. They hope to restart their world tour next year with a reboot of east coast visits at about the same time (April).

I want to highlight one often overlooked club function.....giving to charity. Many dollars have been raised in the past for charities including Leukemia and Hospice.

Just this last month, Gabi Van Wie, our Social Co-chair, donated the food intended for the St Patrick's Day Party, to a local homeless shelter. Going forward, we plan to offer raffles at club events, with a part of the proceeds going to various charities. Our generosity, often on display, speaks volumes about the nature of SOS.

Finally, some good news! The summer sailing season is just around the corner and surely the virus situation will have peaked and subsided by then. John Rogers and his team of coordinators are ready with a great schedule of cruises, punctuated by several cool parties. Meanwhile, we are following state and national guidelines with the goal of keeping our members and the community healthy.

That's it for this month. Stay safe and, like everyone else, I am looking forward to a return to normalcy!

MAJOR CHANGES CONSIDERED FOR MEMBERSHIP DUES

Your Board of Directors is considering some changes to the dues structure of SOS. There are several reasons for considering these changes.

We are now in a situation where over 40% of SOS members are designated as Lifetime members and pay no dues. This is likely to place a financial strain on the club and place a financial burden on those members not eligible to become Lifetime members. Club leaders foresaw this situation more than a decade ago and placed a limit on the number of Lifetime members by making such designation contingent on: a) having joined the club by 3/31/2009 and b) having at least 10 years of membership.

Even with the stop date, there are more than 60 current members who joined the club before March of 2009 and will be reaching the required age of 70 in the not too distant future. Unless we add a significant number of new members, the proportion of non-dues-paying members will continue to rise and will eventually become more than 50% of the SOS club membership.

In addition to the fiscal strain on the club, there is federal tax law which applies to SOS. There is an IRS ruling, applying to social clubs, that says you cannot have different classes of membership, such that one class pays substantially more in dues while both (all) classes receive identical benefits. Although it is highly unlikely that the IRS will come looking at the SOS dues structure, it is also ethically and fiscally responsible to avoid a legal risk to the club's non-profit status.

In view of these issues, the BOD has approved an ad hoc committee to review the fiscal and legal constraints. Our goal is to develop several options for change to the current dues structure. We plan to ask for input from club members before continuing to a final recommendation. Before any change is made to the dues situation of Lifetime members, there would need to be a bylaw change.

Several options for a bylaw change will be offered for member discussion and input.

A final option will be presented for a vote at the August Town Hall Meeting.

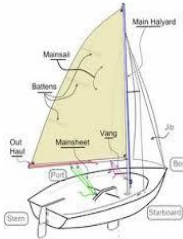

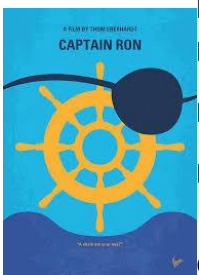

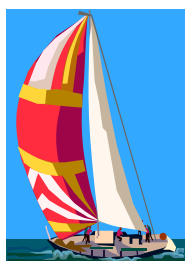
