### **Cruising Corner**

Now that the cruising season is off to a great start, it is time to think about the marina/land-based events this season. Some of the cruises, the skipper will have to make their marina reservation and pay at the time of reservation. If they take at least one crew from the coordination, the club will reimburse them. At other events, the club will make slip reservations and pay for the slips directly. For all coordinated events, signing up early will help the coordinators plan.

For the Anniversary Party June 24-25 at Lankford Bay Marina, the club will reimburse the skippers for those slips where the skippers take at least one crew from the coordination. Lankford Bay Marina wants each skipper to call (410) 778-1414 to make and pay for slip reservations. For the skippers paying for their own slips, the price is \$2,25 per foot, and electric is \$8.00 per 30-amp connection. For those who drive in and wish to spend the night, you'll find the Mariner Motel and the Inn at Haven Harbor in Rock Hall. For Independence Day, it is too early to know where all the fireworks will be on which nights. We plan to go to St. Michaels for July 1 and 2 (two nights), and Skippers Choice for July 3, and sail home on July 4. The Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum will have their Big Band night and fireworks on Saturday



July 1. The two best options in St. Michaels, are the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum (CBMM) and Higgins Yacht Yard. Higgins is an option if you don't have a CBBM membership, but they require a three-night minimum stay. CBMM members at the Mariner level and higher can make a reservation on their website one month ahead (May 30 for July 1- 2) for a two-night minimum stay, Call Higgins Yacht Yard to make a reservation if needed. Once other fireworks displays are announced, we can plan for Skipper's Choice. Skippers will be reimbursed for slips and electric if they accept at least one crew from the coordination. The Seafood Feast will be at Haven Harbor South again this year. Because Haven Harbor South uses Dockwa for reservations and payment, we ask that skippers go to Haven Harbor South website, make their own reservation, and pay for the slip as soon as possible. If you need to cancel, you can get a full refund from Dockwa if done at least 72 hours ahead of time. Skippers can submit for reimbursement for their slip if they have at least one crew member from the coordination. The Haven Harbor South website

The Labor Day 4-Day Cruise will have one night at Zahnisers Marina on September 4. Because Zahnisers uses Dockwa for reservations and payment, we ask that skippers go to Zahnisers website, make their own reservation, and pay for the slip as soon as possible. If you need to cancel, you can get a full refund from Dockwa if done at least 72 hours ahead of time. Skippers can submit for reimbursement for their slip if they have at least one crew member from the coordination.

**Zahnisers** 

**Oktoberfest** will be held at Castle Marina on Kent Island on September 23. The club will reserve and pay for the slips if Skippers have at least one crew from the coordination. For Skippers without crew from the coordination, the slip will be \$2.25 per foot and electric \$8.00 per 30-amp connection.

The last weekend cruise of the season will be **Oysterfest** at CBMM. This will be October 27 - 29, sailing to St. Michaels on Friday and returning home on Sunday. CBMM members at the Mariner level and higher can make a reservation on their website one month ahead (September 27) for a two-night minimum stay. Others can make a reservation at Higgins Yacht Yard next door.

I hope that this column provides some information for the upcoming sailing season that you find useful, and that we all have a great time on the water!

**Cruising** - The Cruising Kickoff was held April 22 with Skippers, First Mates, Coordinators, and Board members in attendance. An education session for the coordinators was held. Dockside training was held on multiple boats April 29 and 30.

**First Mates** – The group met and talked about a range of topics: recruiting new FMs and suggested skills to practice on the upcoming FM Cruise.

We will ask that FM profiles be expanded to include information from each FM as to their experience on catamarans, small boats/tiller boats, and powerboats.

**Safety** – Flare and Safety Day was cancelled due to very bad weather. Hope to reschedule on September 17<sup>th</sup>

Skippers' Advisory – We were happy to see seven new skippers at Cruising Kickoff as well as the participation of several for dockside training either on their boat or as guest skippers on other boats. The skipper mentoring program seems to be going well.

**Social** – Anniversary Party is set and the Liquor License has been submitted.

**New Business** – Dean Collins has been awarded the status of First Mate Emeritus.

August BOD Meeting will be held in person before Town Hall Meeting.

A report was presented from the Newsletter Task Force requesting input from the Board on three issues: We need a graphic designer to modernized and made editable the masthead. One board member will reach out to a graphic designer she knows who may take on this project.

# Come to the "Dinghy Dance"

The "Dinghy Dance" is a fun training session that focuses on the

effective and safe use of dinghies. The training starts with a presentation on what a dinghy is, safety in a dinghy, what the legal requirements are in a dinghy, dinghy etiquette, and more.

Then, since the training is held at a member's private pool with a real dinghy, we can jump into the water and practice getting in and out of a dinghy on land and in deep water. We test some of the techniques that experienced dinghy users rely on, like a stepping strap or a line tied across the dinghy.

In addition, we have videos on different types of PFDs, how to put a PFD on in the water, which PFDs will give you the most protection if you fall out of a boat, and a video on how to inspect and maintain your Inflatable PFD. We jump in the pool wearing different types of PFDs to experience how they vary. We even have two people jump in with an inflatable PFD so participants can observe how the inflatable reacts. This year we plan to have one of those people jump in wearing foulies to see whether the inflatable will stay in place or ride up.


