July Sailing

Sailing in the month of July begins with our 4th July Cruise and ends with the very popular Christmas in July Cruise. And of course, there are a lot of days sails to enjoy as well as the elegant Appetizers & Dessert Cruise.

In Memory of Ursula Z. Skagen



Ursula Z. Skagen, an SOS skipper for thirteen years, and beloved wife of Dane Skagen, died at home at age of 71 on June 6th after a heroic three-year battle with gallbladder cancer. Our Capt. Zula, cast off her lines one last time from this earthly dock on her final solo passage heading for her ultimate horizon.

Ursula was born in Springs, South Africa. Her family immigrated to the US when she was nine years old. After high school at Holy Cross in Palo Alto, CA, she went on to graduate from UC Berkeley in biochemistry. She later obtained her MBA from Wright State University in 1982.

She worked at Rockwell International She then became an investment banker in New York City and Boston, MA, before retiring at age 39 to go sailing in the Caribbean, Central America, and US East Coast. Ursula has been listed as a noteworthy venture capitalist by Marquis Who's Who.

In addition to being a venture capitalist, Ursula held a USCG 100-ton Near Coastal Masters license and had over thirty years of experience cruising, delivering and captaining yachts along the entire Atlantic and Gulf Coasts of the United States, and throughout the Caribbean Sea.

She personally supervised the repowering and rewiring of her Saga 43, *Fortunate Soul*, by Spanish-speaking mechanics located twenty miles up the Rio Dulce in Guatemala, an experience that included having the local milk company fabricate new water and fuel tanks.

In a life filled with adventures, one story she told many times took place in 2016 while delivering a 40-foot sailboat from Panama to Florida when he vessel was overtaken by some 30 pirates. Fortunately, they did not find the drugs and weapons they were looking for and left after pocketing some gear.

There will be a celebration of her life at times and places to be determined, on the water, with sailboats and friends. One such celebration will take place on the Chesapeake Bay.
